Please read these instructions before using the machine

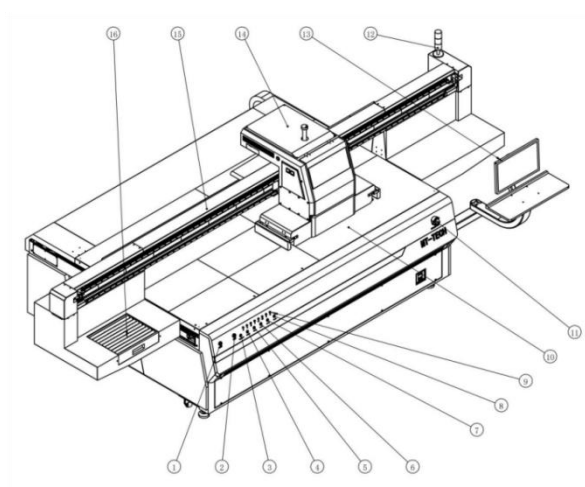
1. Machine should not be used by children or the disabled.If necessary,please under the supervision;
2. Please use original supplier's spare parts and ink under instruction;
3. Make sure the power voltage is same as power cable and machine which shown on the Nameplate;
4. Only suitable to be used indoors and it is better to have air conditioning inside the room to keep stable working temperature and humidity;
5. Dismantle the wooden case and the foot cup fixed frame and put it on a stable table before using;
6. Do not use the machine in a environment which has fire,dust and wetness;
7. Do not use the machine in a humid house;
8. Do not put sundries on the machine itself,the printing table and surroundings;
9. Please keep a stable temperature in the working room,do not use the machine where environment over 30 degrees or below 15 degrees;
10. Do not use any broken cable to provide electricity;
11. If power supply is broken,please stop to using the machine;
12. Power off machine when you clean or fix the machine;
13. Please use the machine according to local legal policy;
14. Make sure the head not touch anything before sending picture.Height sensor do not work when meets transparent materials;
15. When the machine is working, your eyes will feel sick if staring at the UV lamp for a long time, it is better to wear ultraviolet-proof glasses;
16. When needed to move the machine,at least require 4 people to lift.Do not move the machine together with other machine parts. And remember to take take off the power charger when move the machine;
17. When add ink,you may touch ink tube,ink bottle and ink cap and some other parts,please protect yourself in advance;
18. The table which used to put the machine should be make sure its stability to place the machine and protect machine from shaking during working;
19. Do not use UV LED lamp for a long time;

20. Make sure the machine is normally grounded;
21. Do not use the machine in thunderstorm day in order to avoid lightning strikes;
22. If your ink is not come from Nocai,after sale service will not be provided

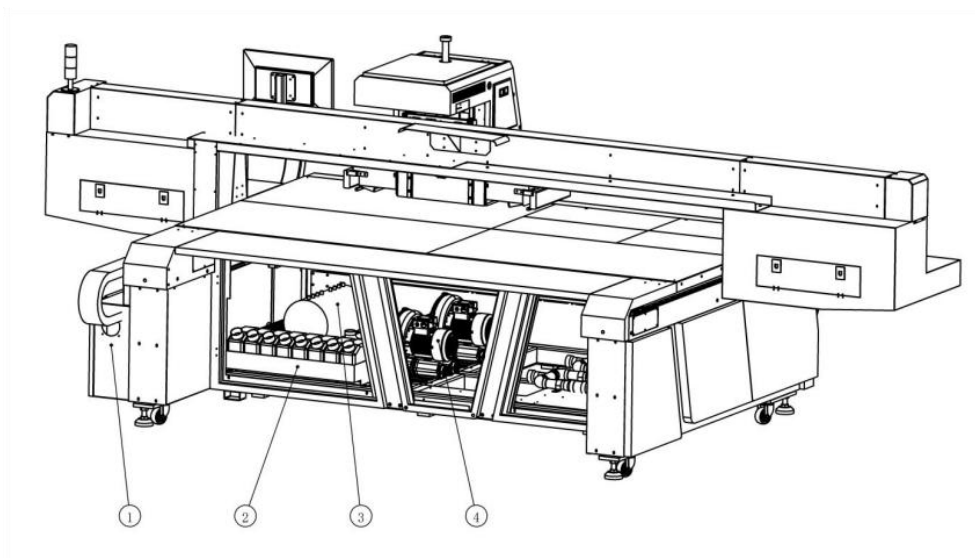
1.1 Graphic analysis of the front and side of the machine

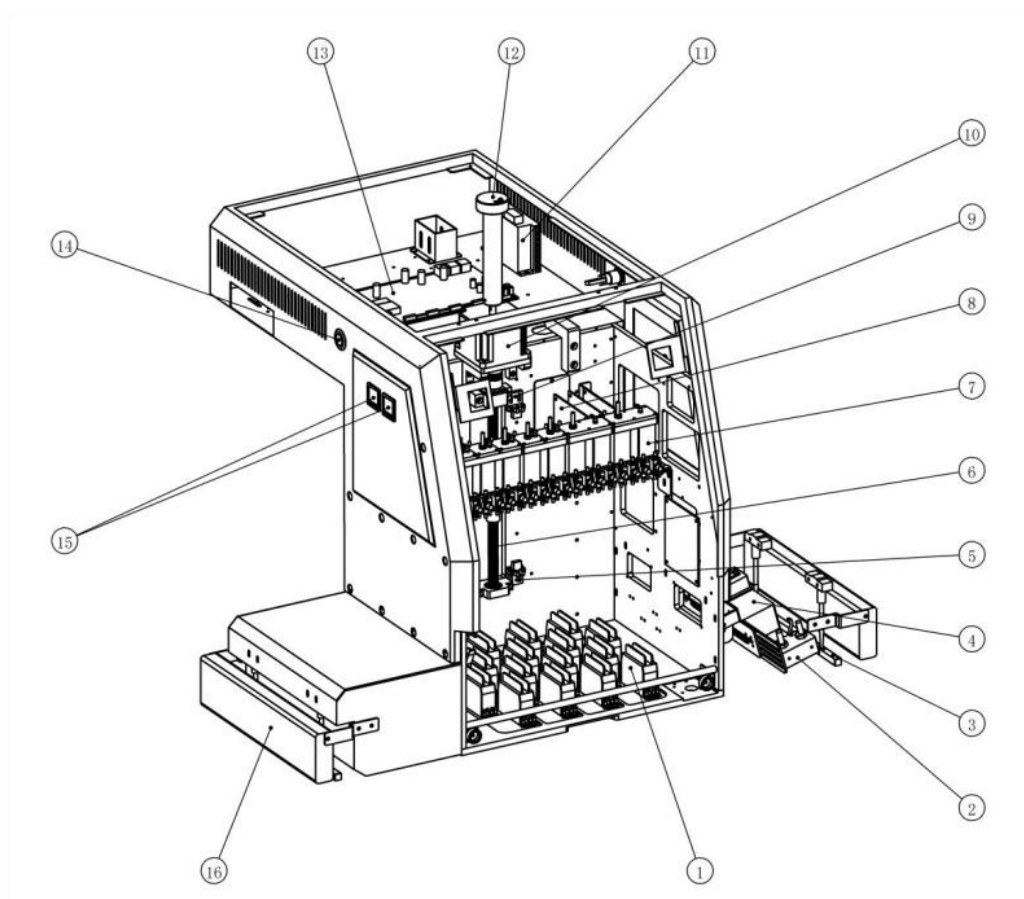
- ①Electrical box: Location of electrical components

- ①Printhead: It is used for printing.
- ②Varnish lamp: Accelerate the UV varnish curing
- ③Ink cart anti-collision device: the role of protecting the printhead
- ④UV lamp: Accelerate ink curing
- ⑤Lower limit sensor of ink station: control the ink station lifting
- ⑥Ball Screw: Converts rotational motion into linear motion
- ⑦Secondary cartridge: Ink is supplied to the printhead controlled by a negative pressure system
- ⑧Printhead Driver Board: Driver control the printhead inkjet
- ⑨Ink station limit sensor: Control the lifting of the ink station

- ⑩42 stepper motor: Control the lifting of the ink cart
- ⑪Leadshine Drive DM556: Precise control of 42 stepper motors
- ⑫Lifting handle: It can control the lifting of the ink cart manually
- ⑬Mainboard:
- ⑭Flash button: press the ink on the printhead and clean the printhead

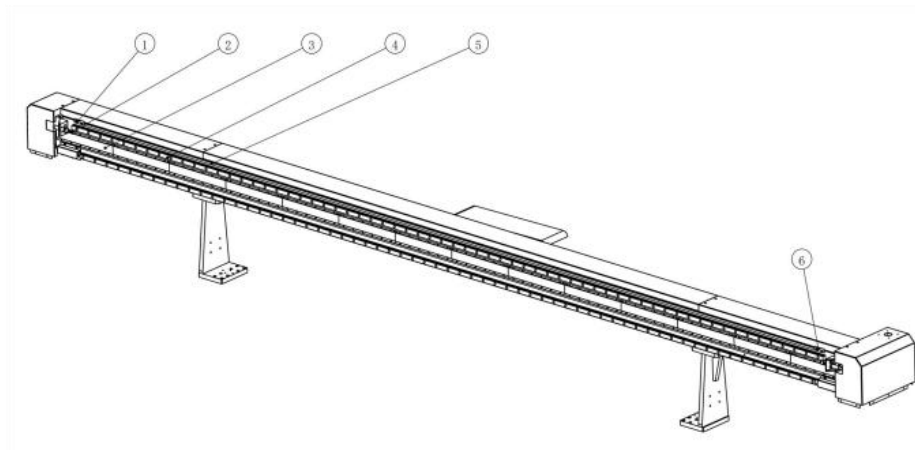

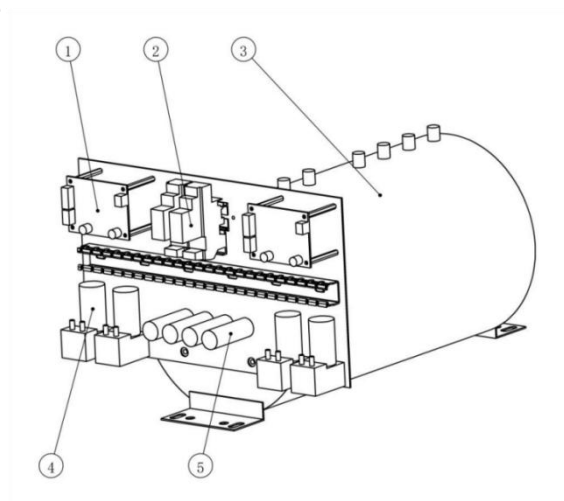

Machine Initialization Confirmation

2.1 Preparations

Make sure that the machine looks normal, and matches the power supply voltage (220V or 110V) of the machine.

2.2 Confirm that the boot initialization process is normal

The machine is powered on, turn on the main power switch at the back of the machine, click the power button on the front panel, the machine starts, and the initialization action is executed.

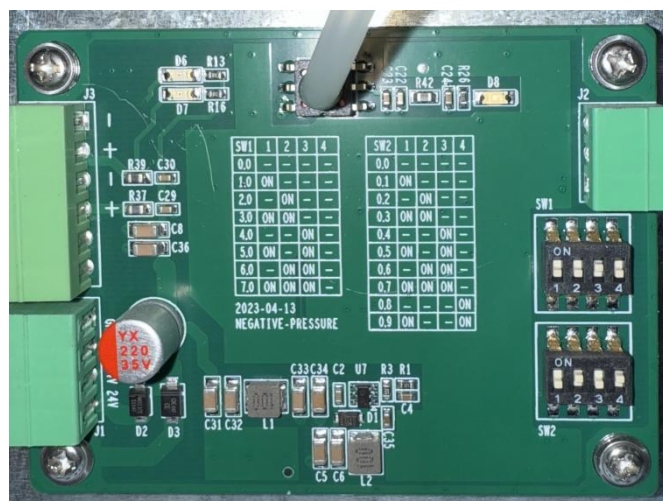
The machine initializes the action process completely.

2.3 The machine is moving normally

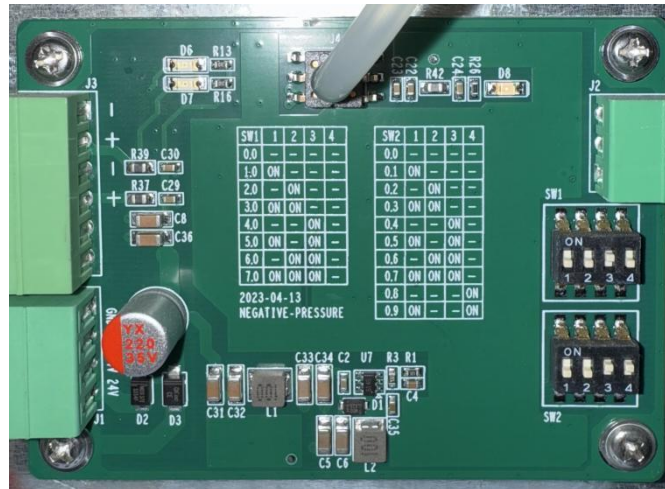
【The network cable connects the computer and the machine→ opens the driver software→ the lower left corner shows that the connection is normal→ the left, right, front and back control in the drive, and the Z-axis controls the up and down→ the machine can feedback normally】

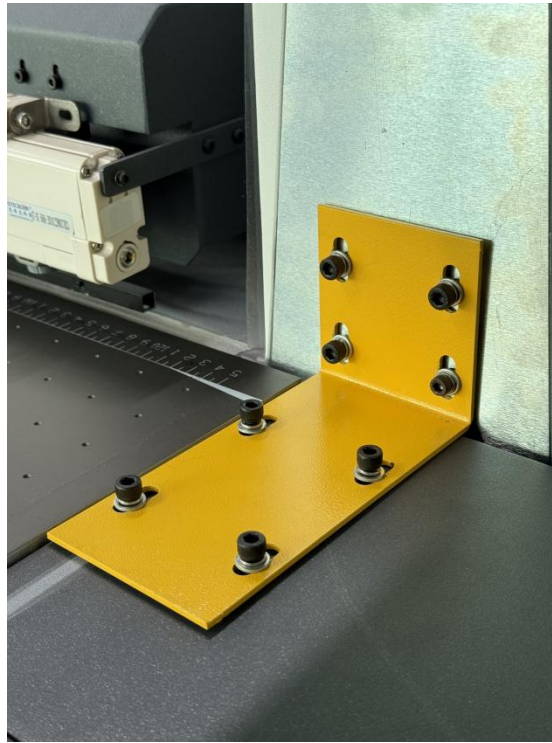

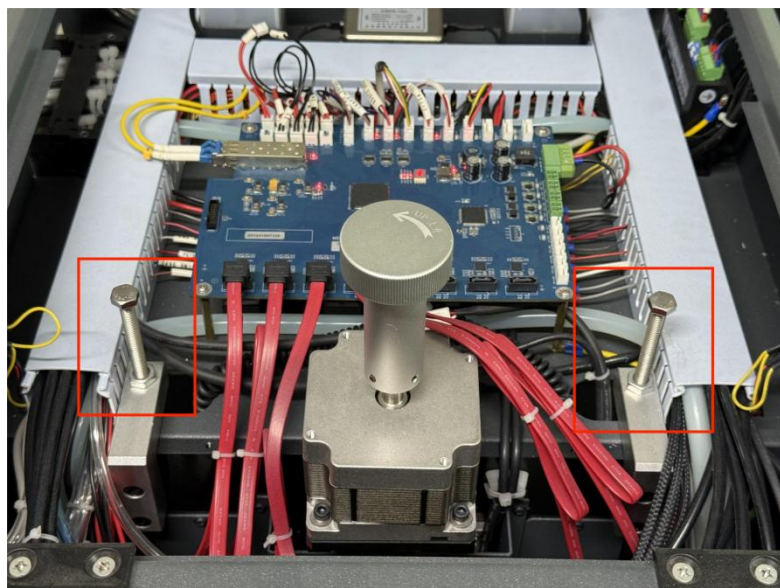
2.6 Fixed sheet metal for the beams

Remember to remove the fixed sheet metal on both sides of the beam for the new machine



2.7 Fixed screws of the cart

Open the front cover of the cart, and there are two screws on both sides to be screwed up or removed, (such as the screws can be screwed off and put on the back plate during the transportation)



How to add ink

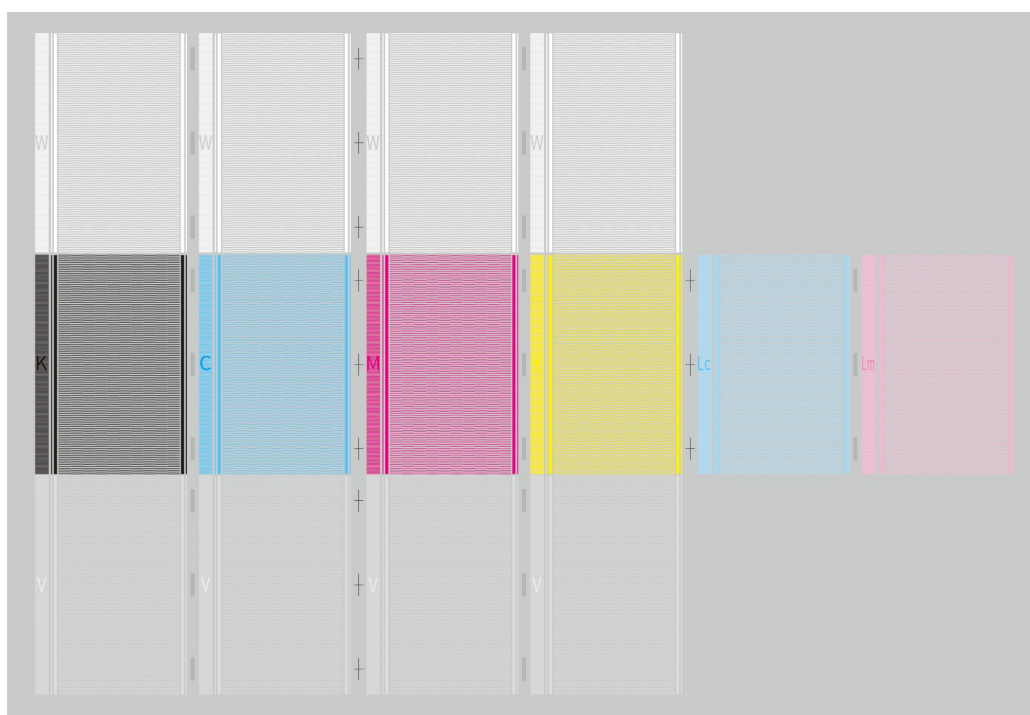
1. Follow the color tips to add the corresponding ink as following.



2. In order to prevent the ink from leaking out and contaminating the shell sheet metal when adding ink, protective measures need to be taken. The bottle mouth can be wrapped with paper. After adding the ink, twist the ink bottle tightly.
3. There are two buttons on both sides of the inkjet cart, the left is the pressing button of color ink, and the right is the pressing button of white ink. Press sequentially and hold it about 5 seconds. After the ink pressing is completed, wipe the surface of the nozzle with a dust-free cloth, adjust the height of the cart, print the nozzle detection graphic, and check the status of the nozzle. The condition of the printhead directly affects the effect. After starting, you need to print the printhead status bar to check whether the printhead is in good condition, if the state is good, you can carry out the operation of the printing task, if the state is not good, or the printing pattern is biased in the middle, you should stop the printing task and check the printhead, usually the ink can be pressed.
4. Print the test strip and open the online driver software PrintExp, the lower left corner shows that the connection is successful, click to test, print the test strip, if there is any lack of color or ink supply-suspension problem, please continue to clean the nozzle, until the test strip is complete. The machine goes into standby.

Install and setup the driver

4.1 Computer requirements

System version: Win7, Win8, or Win10 on a 64-bit system.

Memory: 4GB or more;

Hard disk: 250GB or more.


The computer must be equipped with Gigabit network card and gigabit network cable, only in this way the software can be normal online.

IPv4 address of the computer is set to be obtained automatically.

4.2 Install the driver

1、Install-PrintExp

Start the print and control software, first make sure that the machine has been turned on normally, the initialization action is normal, and the computer has been connected to the machine through the network cable.

PrintExp software can be opened and used directly, first find the folder where the PrintExp software is placed, open it, and find  PrintExp_X64.exe , double-click on the program to launch the PrintExp software.

When the connection is successful,

The ink station will move down, and then the head will be raised.

The lower left corner of the PrintExp software interface shows that the connection is successful (green light).

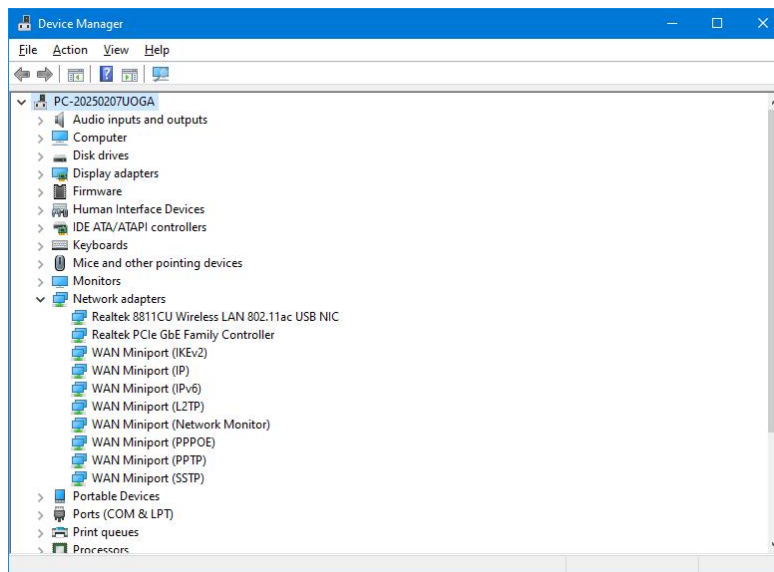
Gigabit network card judgment

Before the network connection, first check the computer's network card must be Gigabit network card to connect normally, the difference between 100 Gigabit network card and Gigabit network card:

Gigabit network cards contain these characters: Gigabit、GBE、10/100/1000M、RTL8169 。

The 100 Gigabit network card contains these characters: Fast Ethernet、10/100、FE。

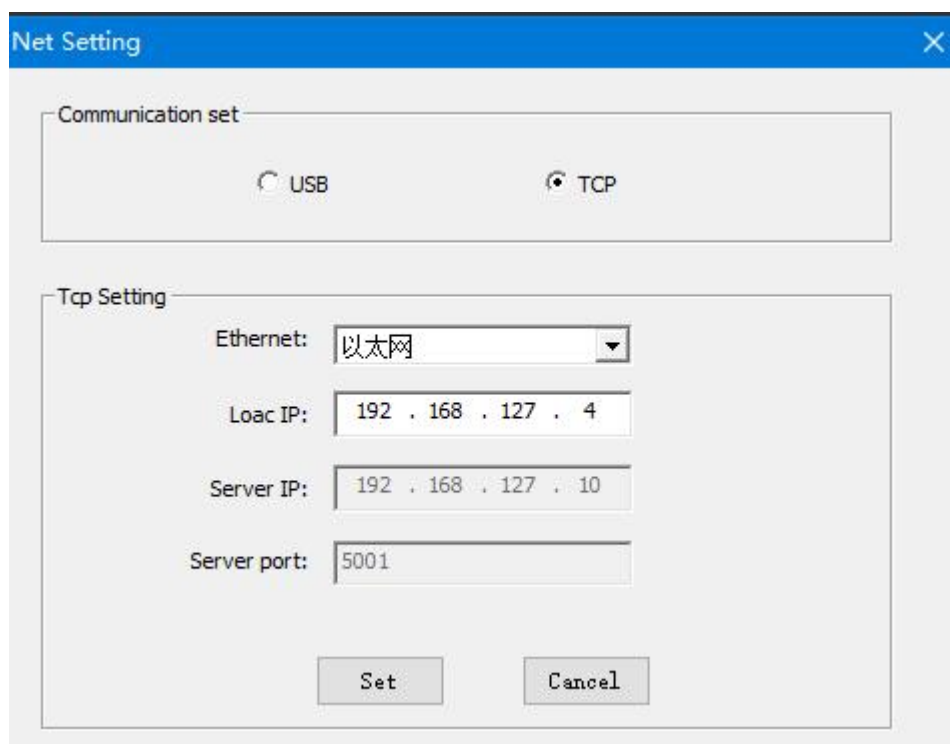
Enter the computer device manager and check the network adapter, as shown in the figure below, it is a 100 Gigabit network card:



3、 Network settings

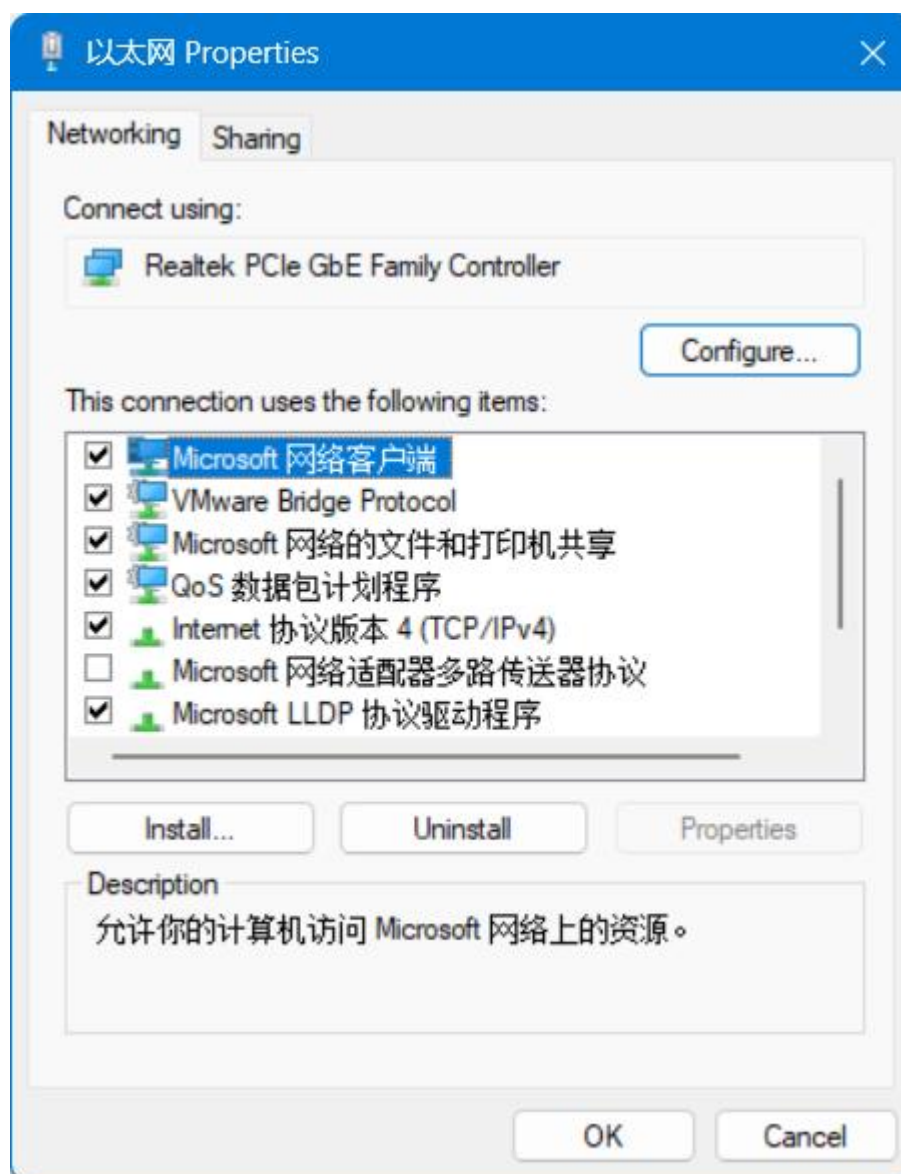
For the first time, you must set the network connection parameters to use it online. Connect the TCP/IP network cable to set up the network.

How to set up the connection: the advanced menu in the online software → the advanced menu→the communication settings, and you can see the communication settings window at this time, as shown in the figure below:



The server IP and server port settings have been fixed, there is no need to set it up, just set the local IP, as shown in the figure above, enter **192.168.127.111** in the local IP position (note that the last three digits can be any number in the range of 1-255 except 10), click "Set" to check if the network connection can be connected normally, if you still can't connect to the machine, you can use the following methods:

Go to the computer control panel → Network & Internet → check the network status and tasks → change adapter settings → click on the Ethernet or local connection → the properties will be shown as the following:

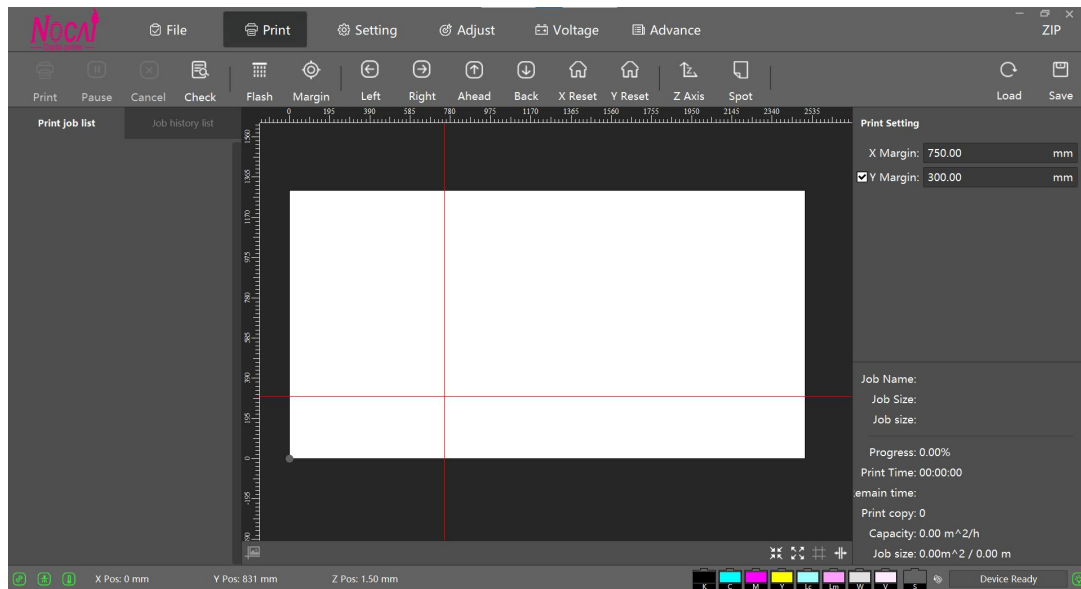

Enter the same address in the red box in the above figure, and click OK. Then go back to the main interface window of the online driver software, you can see that the first icon in the lower left corner of the main interface is displayed as **green**, indicating that the computer is connected, if it is still **red**, it means that it is not connected, you can unplug the network cable and try again to see if it is connected. If you still can't connect to the network, check whether the network cable is go.

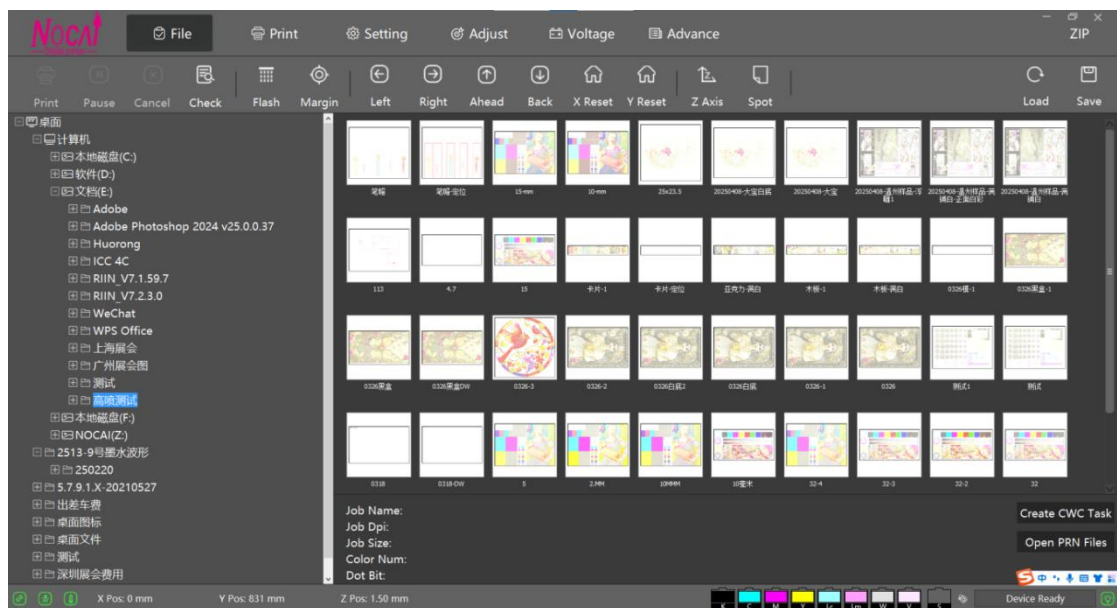
The main interface of PrintExp is shown as the following:

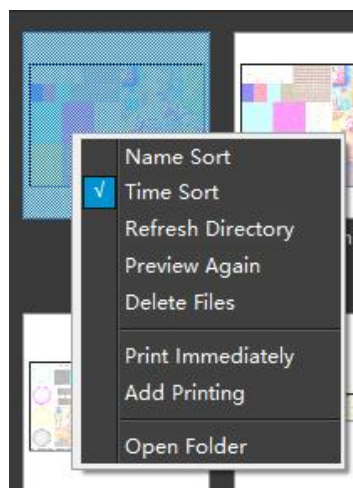
5.1 File

Click the file in the menu bar to enter the file interface, which mainly includes the file directory window, the picture preview window, and the image information display column as shown below:

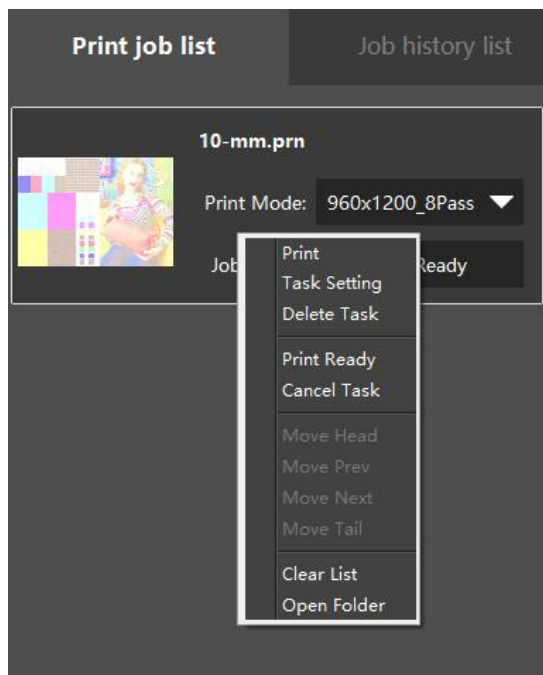



5.4.1 Check the nozzle

Click“Check the nozzle”, the system will print the graphic, as the following:



The normal and abnormal conditions of the black status graphic are partially enlarged, as shown in the figure below:

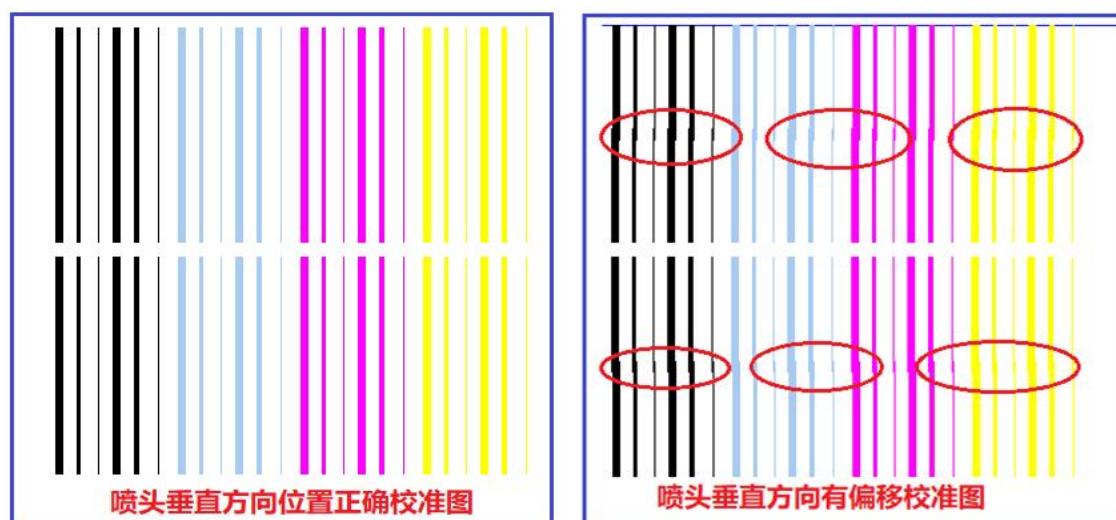




The status graphic in the case of the above diagram may be blocked and needs to be cleaned until the inkjet is in the best condition.

5.4.2 Vertical check function

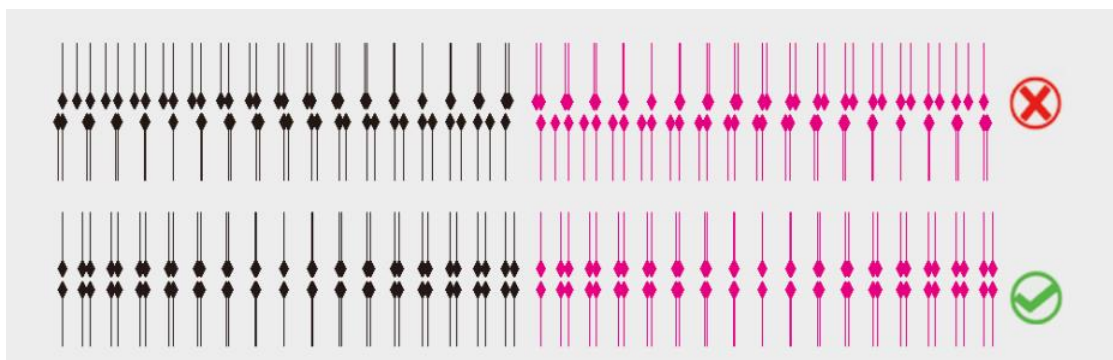
Click "Vertical check", and the system will print the vertical check graphic, as the following:



The calibration diagram on the right side of the above figure needs to be adjusted vertically until the vertical calibration diagram is correct.

5.4.3 Left and right tilt function

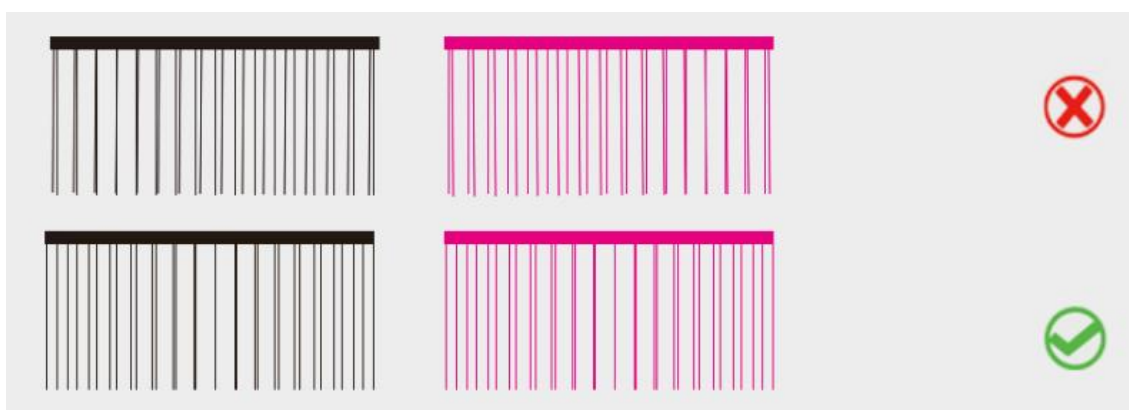
Tilt the calibration interface left and right, and click Print. After the pop-up interface is confirmed, the system will print the left and right tilt calibration picture. As shown below:



Compare with the schematic diagram, the wrong result is that the upper and lower parts of the calibration diagram coincide with each other in the same vertical position, please adjust the corresponding left and right tilt or adjust the left and right tilt of the base plate according to the printhead mark. The correct result is that the upper and lower parts coincide in the same vertical position.

5.4.4 Tilt forward and backward function

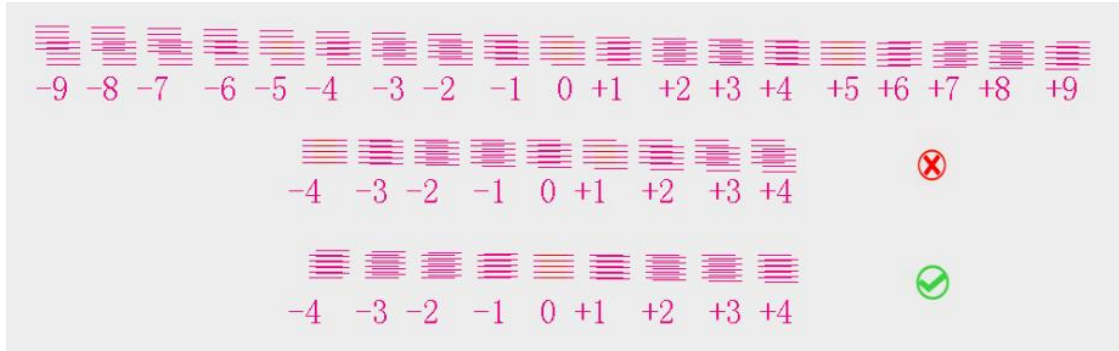
Tilt the calibration interface back and forth and click Print. After the pop-up interface is confirmed, the system will print the picture of the front and rear tilt calibration. As shown below:



Compare the schematic diagram, the wrong result is that the vertical lines of the calibration diagram are crossed, please adjust the corresponding front and rear tilt according to the printhead mark or adjust the front and rear tilt of the base plate. The correct result is that the vertical lines are parallel to each other.

5.4.5 Introduction to step calibration function

Click "Print Calibration Diagram" under the Baseline Step interface, and the system will print the step calibration diagram as follows:

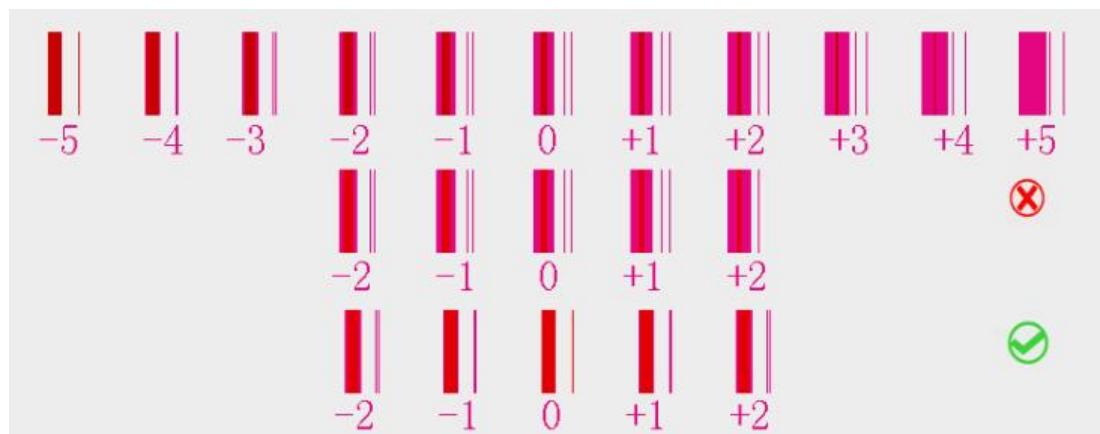


Compare with the schematic diagram, the wrong result is that the calibration line and the guide line coincide with the calibration diagram are not at the 0 position, please enter the value on the right side of the "Print" button according to the value of the coincidence position of the calibration line and the reference line, and then click the "Calculate" button to calibrate.

The correct result is that the calibration line and the guide line coincide at position 0.

5.4.6 Horizontal spacing calibration of the printhead

Click "Print Left/Right Calibration Chart" of the printhead horizontal spacing calibration interface and the system will print as follows:

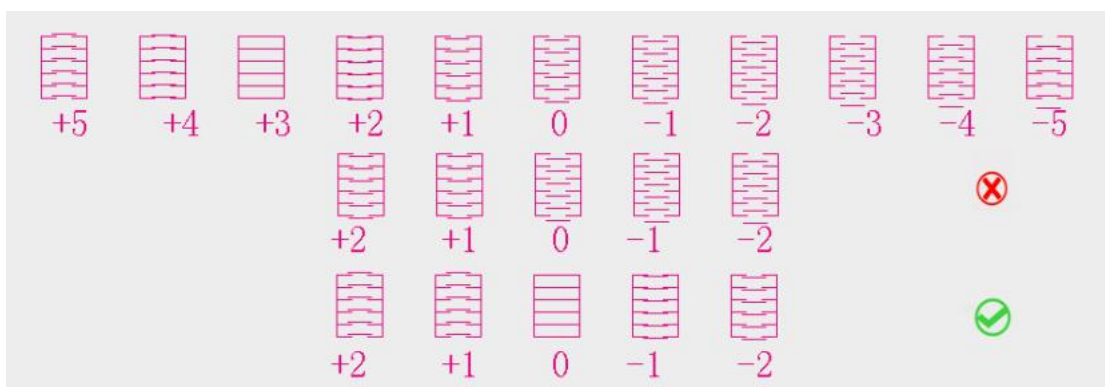


Compare the schematic diagram, the wrong result is that the calibration line and the reference line coincide with the calibration diagram are not at the 0 position, please add or subtract on the original basis according to the value of the coincidence position of the calibration line and the reference line, and then enter it in the corresponding input interface marked by the corresponding printhead. The correct result is that the calibration line and the guide line coincide at position 0.

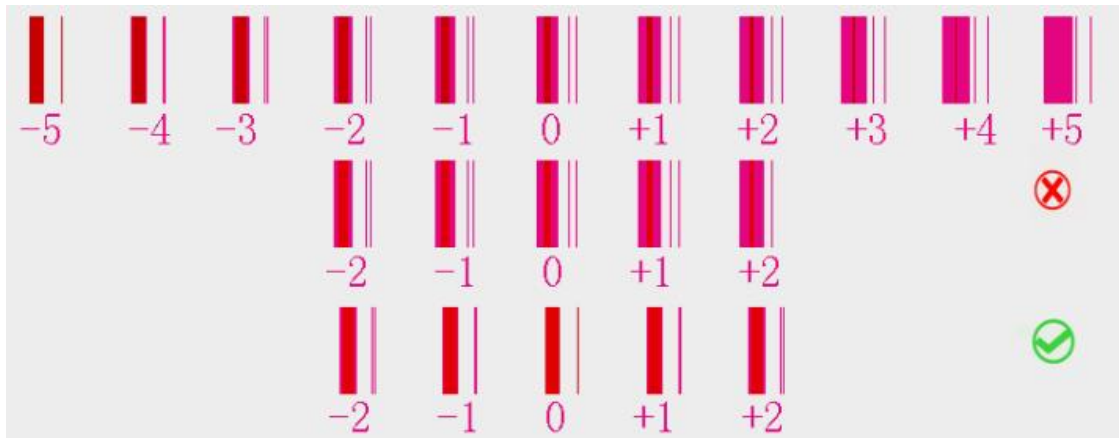

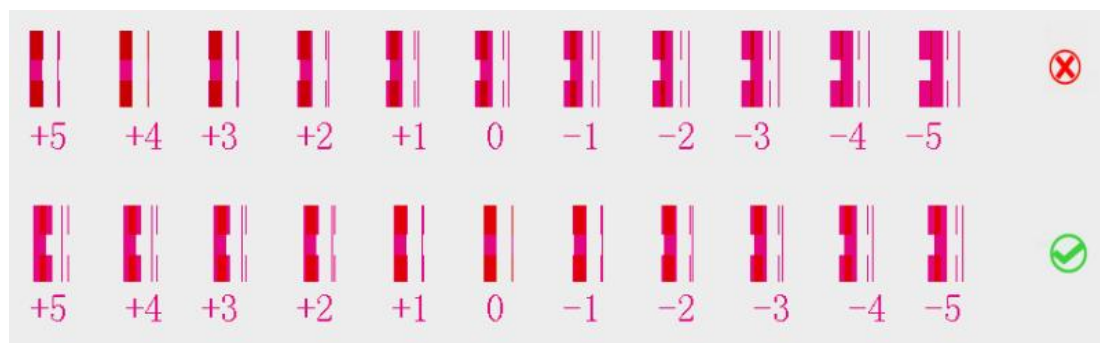

You can see the operation, especially when there is an error or fault, and you can know what kind of error message is generated by viewing the debugging information, so as to solve the error specially.



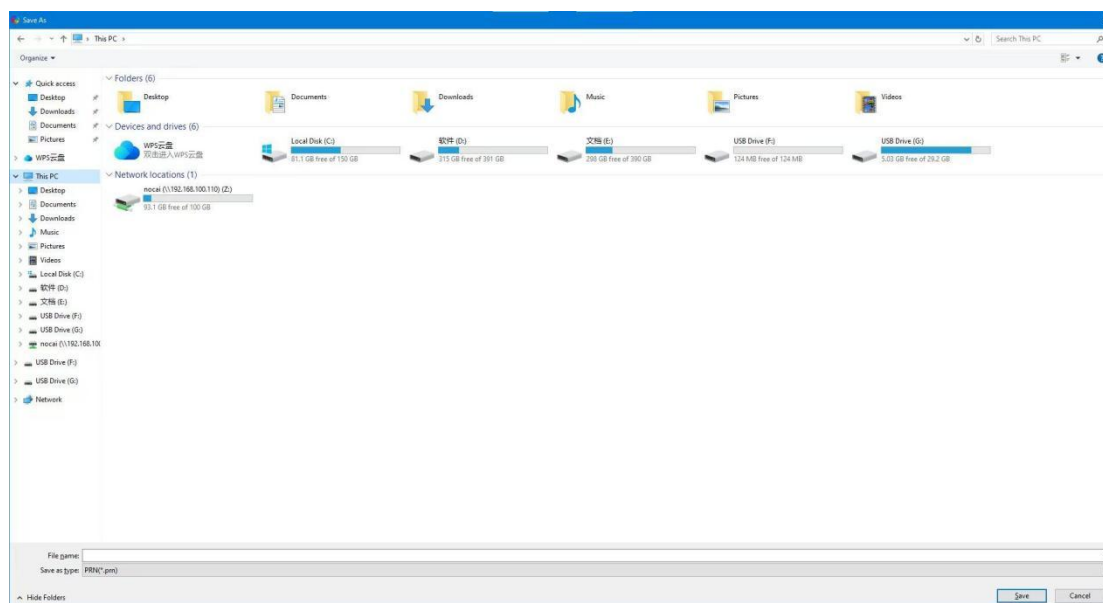
Click 'Print' in the menu bar will launch the Print Confirmation dialog, as shown below:



Here you can set the parameters for printing:

1. Solution: Select one for printing.
2. Send type: Print to the file port (Send type: FILE) or print to the network port (Send type: TCP/IP) . Print to the file port is to generate PRN file firstly and then open it by Printer Manager. At last, print it. Print to the network port is to process the picture and print at the same time, there is no PRN file. Simply keep Printer Manager running in the background with parameters configured.

Print to the file port, click“Print”, the interface is as shown below:



Maintenance method and announcements

7.1 Maintenance method of printhead

- ① There is a board chip inside the nozzle, which is directly inserted with the nozzle line. You need to pay attention to the head cable and contact parts, be sure to prevent ink dripping. Once the head cable parts and the printhead has a watery contact, turn off the machine immediately, and remove it for blow-drying. Only in this way can you test whether it is burned or not, and remember not to use with water, otherwise it will burn the printhead and the head board.
- ② Due to the head cable and the plug is tightly connected. So after a long time there will be contact oxidation, damage, misalignment or contact another cable, so when unplugging the head cable you need to pay attention to check these problems carefully, and exclude or replace the head cable, otherwise it will result in the burnt out of the printhead or head board.
- ③ When not using the machine you must maintain the printer once a day, power-on it once and print the test strip, if the test strip is not complete, please clean automatically to ensure that the test strip is normal. Use the cleaning solution 3-5 drops of ink in the cap top when more than 3 days of vacation unattended. And then combine and seal the printhead and the cap top, which will protect the printhead.
- ④ When the ink is added to the cartridge, you'd better use the method of adding less diligently, the expiry of the ink is 3 months after opening. Otherwise it will produce deterioration, which will affect the printing effect and cause clogging of the printhead, it is recommended that the customer stir the ink regularly and open the switch at the white ink cartridge when using the machine.
- ⑤ The height of the printhead from the material should be 2-3mm. Confirm the height timely in order to avoid printhead is damaged.
- ⑥ Sheet metal of the cart must be cleaned regularly to avoid effects on the printhead.
- ⑦ Avoid printing transparent materials that can cause printhead clogging.

7.2 Magnetic grid maintenance

The magnetic grid strip is a part that controls the printing accuracy in the card slot, the magnetic grid will be scratched by the sensor when working out of the slot, and there will be direct scratches in the future, and the accuracy will reduce or can not read the data to cause the cart to hit, so be sure to check the position when using the printer, whether it is in the middle, whether it has been rubbed, in the dust or dirty air, the magnetic grid strip will be adsorbed by particles or dust to cause dislocation and other problems, please clean and wipe in time (alcohol). Keep the magnetic grid clean and undamaged, and replace it in time if there are scratches that cause misalignment.

7.3 Guide Rail maintenance

The guide rail contains cart guide rail. There is lubricant between guide rail and slider, please add lubricant regularly in order to avoid corrosion. If you find that there is black oil on it, you need to use alcohol to wipe firstly and then add lubricant.

7.4 Suction platform maintenance

This printer is equipped with suction function, there are many dense holes on the platform to produce suction to the material on the platform, so please keep the platform clean, and avoid blocking the suction holes to cause the suction is not strong, or watery objects are sucked into the air holes to hurt the fan.

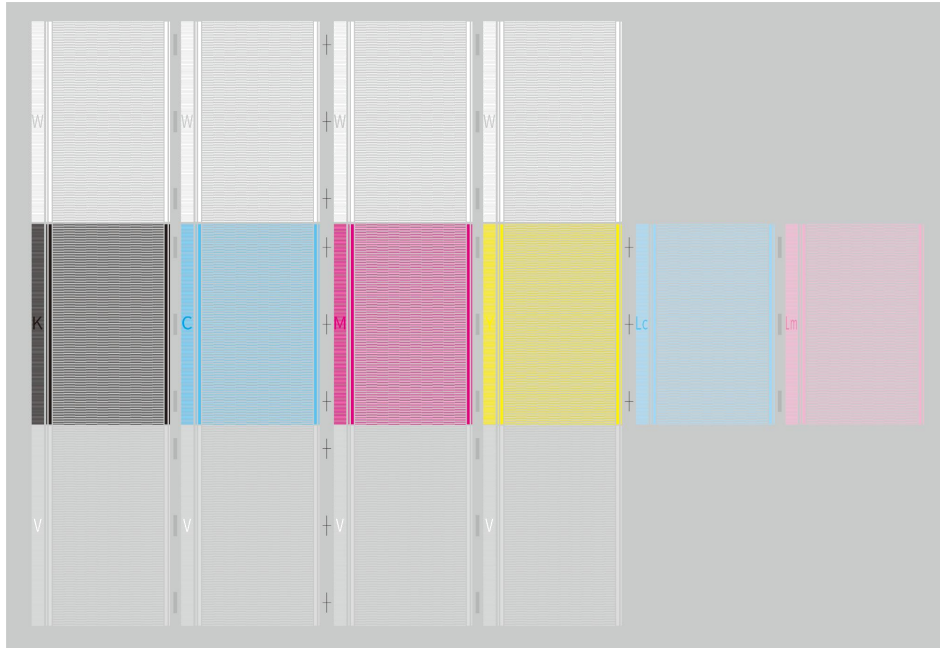
7.5 Maintenance of shell sheet metal

Keep the shell clean, if there is any droplet, please scrub it to avoid ink corrosion on the outer paint surface of the sheet metal.

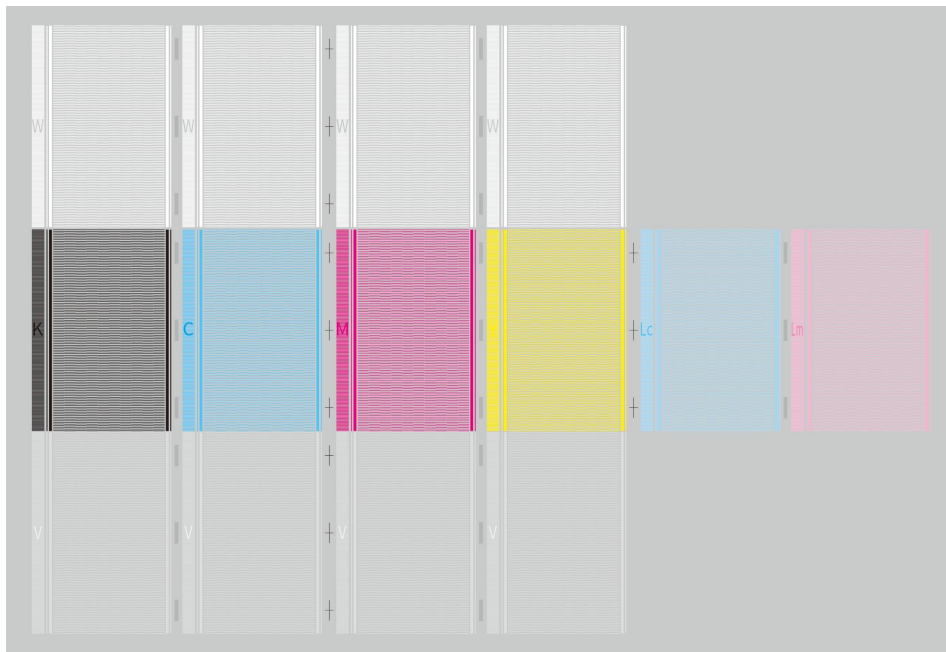

8.1 Common examples of ink-supply suspension problems

Note: The partial ink-supply suspension problem of the test strip is caused by the corrosion of the ink to the print head. You can choose automatic cleaning. If it cannot solve the problem, you can continue to use it without affecting the print

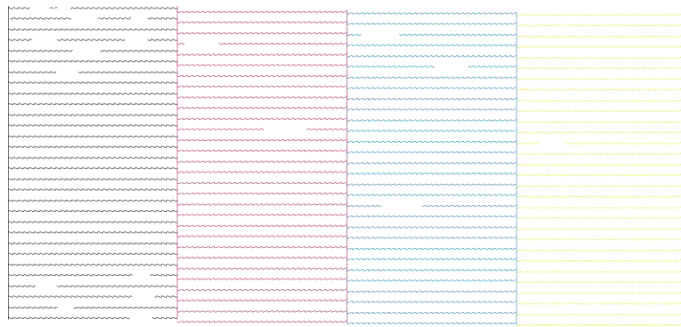

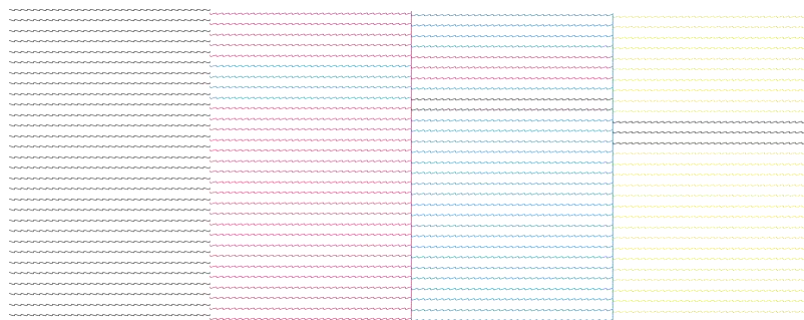


Solution:

1. Check whether the ink can flow out normally, and eliminate the possibility of blockage and air leakage.
2. Clean the print head manually to ensure that the print head is not blocked.
3. Replace the headboard.

Problem Overview: The above problems generally occur due to the ink entering the receptacle of head cable or the improper operation after replacing the printhead, resulting in a short circuit of the printhead, burning the head board or printhead, because the head will damage the head board, but the head board will not damage the printhead. It is recommended to give priority to replacing the printhead and the new head cable.

Color mixing: large area color mixing

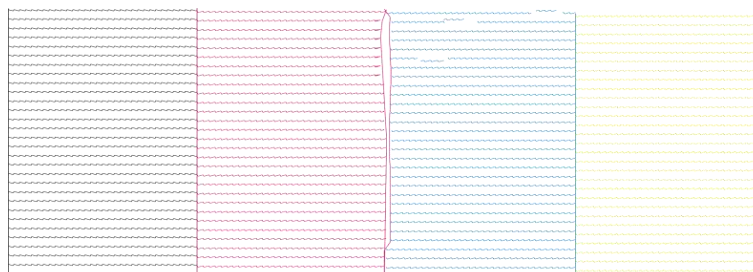


Solution:

1. Please flush the ink firstly, then print a test strip to check whether the color mixing situation improves or not. If not, please check whether there is residue on the surface of the printhead. Wipe the printhead surface clean with a lint-free cloth.
2. Replace the printhead.

Problem Overview: When the above problem occurs, firstly check whether there is residue on the surface of the printhead.

Test Pattern Droplet Deflection



Solution:

1. Check whether the height of the printhead is within 2-3mm from the printing medium.
2. The printing environment is within the range of 15°C~30°C.
3. Stir the ink evenly, and then clean the print head. If the problem cannot be solved, it is recommended to replace the ink.

Problem Overview: If the above problems occur, and if there is no special change in the surrounding environment, it is because of the ink sedimentation caused by the machine being extended inactivity.

8.2 Cart with great resistance

1、 The cart moves to the middle of the machine to start, and the cart does not move to report an error.

1.1 When the machine is turned on, move the cart by hand to see if it can be pushed easily, if so, please check whether the X-axis drive motor indicator light is on or flashing red to report error, and whether the base screw of the motor pulley is tightened.

1.2 Check the cart board LED status; if unlit, replace its data cable.

1.3 Replace the cart board.

1.4 Check that the X-axis motor pulse signal line has these problems such as loose, broken, and aging problem.

1.5 Replace the mainboard.

Problem Overview: Please check the hardware architecture firstly.

2、 The cart moves to the middle of the machine to start, and then moves left to report an error

2.1 Replace the cable of cart board.

2.2 Replace the cart board.

2.3 Replace the mainboard.(Highly unlikely)

Problem Overview: If the above problem occurs, the cart board cannot receive the instructions sent by the mainboard normally.

3、 The cart moves to the middle of the machine to start, and then it moves right to report an error

3.1 Check whether the light is on or not, and if not, it is recommended to replace the magnetic grid sensor.

3.2 Whether there are obvious scratches on the magnetic grid strip, if any, it is recommended to replace it.

3.3 Whether there is ink, oil stains, or dust on the magnetic grid strip, if so, please wipe it with alcohol.

3.4 Whether the magnetic grid strip is stuck in the middle of the magnetic grid sensor, centering left and right, up and down, moving back and forth without scratching.

3.5 Whether the magnetic grid sensor is stuck in the slot.

3.6 Replace the cart board.

Problem Overview: The above problem is because the cart has received the command from the mainboard, but the magnetic grid sensor cannot read data correctly.

4、 During the printing process, the machine reports errors occasionally

4.1 Whether there are obvious scratches on the magnetic grid strip, if any, it is recommended to replace it.

4.2 Whether the magnetic grid strip has ink, oil stains, dust, clean it with alcohol.

4.3 Whether the magnetic grid strip is stuck in the middle, left and right up and down centered, moving back and forth without scratching.

4.4 Whether the X-axis motor belt is loose.

4.5 Whether the base screws of the motor cart are tightened.

4.6 Replace the cable of the mainboard.

4.7 Check whether the temperature of the X-axis drive motor is above 50 degrees, if so, reconnect the X-axis drive signal cable or check whether the X-axis drive motor is parallel to the transverse belt (note that below 50 degrees is within the normal range).

Problem Overview: The magnetic grid sensor can read the data, but there will be an error data feedback.

5、 The cart moves to the middle to turn on, the ink cart moves to the left, then to the right, and crashes to the left after reaching the ink station, and returns to the middle to report an error.

5.1 Check whether the origin sensor is offset or not.

5.2 Replace the cart origin sensor.

5.3 Replace the cable of the cart origin sensor.

5.4 Replace the cart board.

6、 The front and rear limit sensors are incorrect

6.1 Pull up the front and rear limit sensor cables.

6.2 Replace the front and rear limit sensor.

6.3 Check whether the connection cable of the limit sensor is loose, broken or aging.

6.4 Replace the mainboard.

8.3 Ink does not dry

All products are not dry:

1. Check whether the UV lamp lights up or not during printing. If it does not light up, please refer to the solution of UV light.

The edges of the product are not dry:

1. Confirm the version number (Pull down the setting menu to find the device information)
2. Manufacturer make sure the version number and upgrade the printer.
3. Adjust the UV lamp in the advanced settings of the driver panel.

8.4 Nozzle exhaust

Close all valves and make the negative pressure gauge zero. Unscrew the printhead cap with a container. Open the valve, press the button, and flush until the ink flow is smooth. It is very easy to check if there are bubbles. Press the button again to drip ink from the nozzle, then close the valve. Repeat this for each valve. Finally, open all valves, prime again, and reset the vacuum gauge to its original value.

8.5 Digital tube display code mapping

Digital display codes: Initialization procedures and alarm messages:

Digital tube A: If the fiber optic cable is not connected, connect it to initiate the following actions.

Digital tube 1: Raise the Z-axis to the specified height (the distance moved in the positive direction from the origin).

Digital tube 2: Raise the X Y-axis to the specified height (the distance moved in the positive direction from the origin).

Digital tube 3: The XY axes perform a two-stage homing sequence to the limit switches: the second stage involves a slow-speed movement to locate the limit switch precisely.

Digital tube 4: The XY axes move away from the limit switches to a designated position, which is set as the home position (defined by the retraction distance after triggering the limit).

Digital tube 5: The Z-axis performs a homing sequence: it first locates the limit switch, then retracts to a designated position which is set as the home (zero) position, and finally rises to the media height.

Digital tube 6: The secondary ink cartridge is low.

Digital tube 0: Initialization Complete.

Digital tube 9: Ink ingress into the air reservoir.
